

**A MEETING OF COTON PARISH COUNCIL

1. APOLOGIES

Apologies were received from Mrs Darling and Mr Chandler.

2. PLANNING APPLICATION

S/0603/2003/F Cambridge Preservation Society, St Catharine's Hall Farm, Coton – amendment to change of Use to a Wildlife and farm Reserve – Revision to access routes drawings correcting previous inaccuracies, Grantchester Road gateway entrance plan, Details of pond Areas A & B.

It was proposed by Mr Kinsey and seconded by Dr Connolley that the plan be approved. This was unanimously agreed.

3. VILLAGE GREEN

It was reported by Clerk that a letter had been received from Mr G.Mitchell stating that he would no longer be cutting the village green. Having spoken to Vice-Chairman (in absence of Chairman), Clerk had requested Herald Contract to cut the grass, which was being done.

Mr Kinsey said that Mr S. Mitchell was now willing to cut the grass at the same price as Mr G. Mitchell.. It was proposed by Mr Kinsey and seconded by Dr Connolley that he be formally asked to cut the village green and be paid normally at the end of the year. This was agreed with 7 for and 1 abstaining. Clerk to write to Herald contract about this.

It was agreed Mr G. Mitchell be paid for the four cuts he had carried out – 4 x £20. - £80.00.
