1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Dr. Connolley and Mrs P. Brown.

2. MEMBERS DECLARATION OF INTERESTS for items on the agenda.

There were no declarations of interest.

3. TO CONSIDER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RECEIVED

S/0922/04/f Ms A. Engleman, Land at Grantchester Road, Barton Parish. – Formation of Golf Driving Range, Five Hole Golf Course, Range Building, Club House and Store (Not in Coton Parish)

It was proposed by Mr Chandler and seconded by Mr Lewis that Coton make no recommendation and commend as follows: Coton PC make no recommendation. There is a positive benefit for the community for the use of the facility, however, we have concerns regarding increased traffic, especially with the proposed Wildlife & Farm Reserve.

This was agreed with 6 for and 1 against.

S/1006/04/O Downing College – Laundry Farm, Barton Road, Cambridge – Renewal of Planning Permission for Playing Fields etc.

It was proposed by Mr Kinsey and seconded by Mr Chandler that this be approved. This was agreed.

4. INSURANCE

Having obtained a quote from Suffolk ACRE Clerk reported total cost for insurance from ACRE was (this did not include the skateboard)  
Total cost from Cornhill was plus quote from Zurich for pavilion totalled  
This included everything.

It was proposed by Mr Kinsey and seconded by Mr Lewis that quotes from Cornhill and Zurich be accepted. This was agreed.

It was agreed an out of council cheque can be made out.

Clerk reported she had been approached by someone from British Heart Foundation to ask if their annual walk could start from the Recreation Ground.

Normally starts at The Orchard but they have difficulty making sure everyone crosses the road at the Plough safely. It was agreed to tell them about the new crossing place in Brook Lane and refuse their request to start on the Recreation Ground because of the number of cars it could generate.
